#### WHAT IS TSPLOST?



**Transportation Special Purpose Local** Option Sales Tax



November 8, 2016, Fulton County residents (not including the City of Atlanta) voted to approve a 0.75-cent TSPLOST I

- April 1, 2017 to March 30, 2022
- Up to \$655M for Fulton County



















#### STRATEGIC PLAN & LOCAL ROAD SAFETY PLAN
